ASH WEDNESDAY is a universal day of fasting and abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. (2013 Liturgical Calendar, pp. 50-51)

Although specific references and images have changed, the content remains the same because it is based on the Sacred Scripture, Apostolic Tradition, the living Tradition of the Church and the authentic Magisterium. The catechism is an excellent reference tool for Catholics wanting to rediscover or broaden their understanding of our values. We may find an older version more difficult to understand and apply. In 2011, the YOUCAT was published which primarily targets young adults and is accompanied by pictures, quotations, and definitions. The YOUCAT program for our parish will be presented over 4 weeks (four 2½ hour meetings). We are hoping to begin on Friday, February 22nd and we hope you can join us. La liturgie du Carême dispose en effet les catéchumènes par les divers degrés de l'initiation chrétienne, et les fidèles, par la commémoration du baptême et par la pénitence, à célébrer le mystère pascal. » (Normes universelles de l'année liturgique, no. 27; cité dans l'Ordo 2013, p. 212)

Season of Lent

“Lent has two major purposes: It recalls or prepares for baptism, and emphasizes a spirit of penance. Through 40 days of closer attention to God's word and of more fervent prayer, believers are prepared to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. Lenten instructions stress these baptismal and penitential themes. During Lent, it is important to teach the social consequences of sin as well as the fact that the heart of the virtue of penance is hatred of sin as an offence against God. The Church encourages penitential practices that are external and social, reflecting the circumstances of individuals and communities, as we pray and do penance for sinners.” (See CSL, nos. 109-110; quoted in 2013 Liturgical Calendar, p. 136)
